- Sanctioned by:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Florida Gold Coast Swimming, Inc.: Sanction No. FGS092217SUN-B-21
- In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Florida Gold Coast Swimming, Inc., the City of Sunrise, Sunrise Swimming and Sunrise Swimming Booster Club shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event
- Conditions of Sanction:** The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (C). Water depth at the start is at least 4'6" in accordance with 202.3.7 (C). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3.
- Hosted by:** Sunrise Swimming, Sunrise Swimming Booster Club, City of Sunrise
- Location:** Sunrise Civic Center

- Directions:** From the east, take Oakland Park Blvd. to just west of Nob Hill Rd. Turn left after Safety Complex. From the south, take Nob Hill north to Oakland Park Blvd. Turn left on Oakland Park, and left again after the Safety Complex
- Date & Time:** **Friday September 22, 2017: Warm up at 5 pm; meet starts at 5:30 pm**
- Pool/Timing:** Competition is in the Sunrise Civic Center Pool 50 meters x 25 yards heated outdoor pool. 8 short-course racing lanes will be used. Separate warm-up and warm down lanes will be available. Daktronics Timing System® will be used.
- Camera Free:** The Florida Gold Coast Swimming **CAMERA FREE ZONE** policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.
- Image Authorization:** All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions.

- Rules:** 2017 USA Swimming and FGC rules will govern this meet. In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Florida Gold Coast Swimming, Inc., the City of Sunrise, Sunrise Swimming and Sunrise Swimming Booster Club shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims from damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- Safety rules as outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the referee, will be in effect. All sessions are timed finals for all swimmers.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations.
- Eligibility:** Open to all current 2017 USA swimming registered athletes and foreign athletes with proper travel credentials who have been invited by USA Swimming who are aged 8 and under. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3
- The Meet Host **Will Not** be accepting new or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All USA Registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.

- Deck Change:** Changing, in part or whole, into or out of a swimsuit (excluding a drag suit) in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes while at a practice, competition or other pool-related activity is strictly prohibited.
- Entry Deadline:** All entries must be received by **Wednesday, September 13, 2017**
- Entry Limit:** 4 Individual events and the relay
- Entry Procedure:** Please confirm your attendance on swim manager.
- NOTE: Swimmers who are not USA Swimming registered will not be entered.**
- Deck Entries:** THE FGC DECK SEED POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT. Deck entries permitted into open lanes only on a first-come-first-serve basis. Deadline for deck entries is 5:15pm (15 min before start of meet). Policy can be seen at [www.fgcswym.org](http://www.fgcswym.org). **Coaches only, please.** All deck entered swimmers must be USA Swimming registered in order to be entered.
- Deck entry fees are **DOUBLE** the entry fee: \$20.00. Cash only.

**Refunds:** Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed, there will be no refunds in full or in part.
